After collecting and reviewing assessment data, bring together key stakeholders for a final review and discussion to determine opportunities for continuous improvement, lessons learned and important information that you will disseminate.

- 1. What are three main takeaways that we have learned from the results of the assessment?**

- 2. What are we doing well that we should continue doing?**

- 3. What could we improve?**
 - a. *What minor course or program adjustments could be made to enhance global student learning in the next semester or academic year?***

 - b. *Has the assessment identified any existing gaps or new needs that must be addressed?***

 - c. *What are some larger, more substantive changes that may be beneficial in the future?***

- 4. Future Recommendations - what ideas does this assessment raise for the future?**
Upon disseminating the assessment findings, solicit input from faculty, staff and students, as relevant to gather ideas for the future.
