Adventures to Dreams Enrichment is a Long Beach nonprofit that empowers diverse youth (ages 5-16) to dream BIG and BELIEVE they can achieve anything in life. Our free enrichment program is based on the idea that "busy hands = busy minds." We teach youth to grow food from seeds and engage them in Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math (STEAM) projects. Art engages youth with creativity and imagination, from painting to pottery. These hands-on experiences prepare children to succeed in school and beyond by equipping them with problem-solving skills and knowledge in nutrition and sustainable agriculture.
