	ENGL 380: Approaches to English Studies (4)	ENGL 180 or Equivalent

Complete 34 UNITS in consultation with a faculty advisor by adhering to the following requirements (34 units total):

21 units in the Department of English at CSULB
 21 units of upper division courses
 15 upper division units applicable to the Special Emphasis Program completed after it has been officially approved
 Electives may not include ENGL 100 or 101
