

I wanted to inform you that The Wall Street Journal [recently announced](#) the creation of the [WSJ Finance Reporting Fellowship](#), a training program that aims to develop early career journalists with an interest in covering financial markets and personal finance.

The 12-month fellowship, offered in partnership with the National Association of Hispanic Journalists (NAHJ) and The City University of New York's (CUNY) Craig Newmark Graduate School of Journalism, is open to journalists with one to three years of paid newsroom experience who want to cover markets or personal finance.

Two journalists will be selected for the inaugural session, which runs from January to December of 2023. Journalists of underrepresented communities are especially [encouraged to apply](#).

Applicants to the WSJ Finance Reporting Fellowship should [submit their completed applications](#) by Oct. 24, 2022.
