- Jana Carpenter Whittier Union H.S. District Memorial Scholarship (\$1,000-\$2,500)
 - Must be a graduate from the Whittier Union High School District.
 - Must be a declared major within the College of Liberal Arts at CSULB.
 - Must maintain a GPA of 3.0 or better.

Communications Department Scholarships

Audrey Nichol Hauth Scholarship (\$3,000)

- Must be a full-time upper level undergraduate or graduate student.
- > Must be a Communication Studies major or minor.
- Must commit to working an average of 6 hours per week in the Luster E. and Audrey Nichol Hauth Center for Communication Skills during the semester of the award.
- Must have at least a minimum cumulative 3.5 GPA.
- Must demonstrate financial need.

Irv B. and Karen A. Gamal Award (\$1,000)

- Must be a declared major in Communication Studies.
- Must maintain a 2.5 GPA or better for initial application. Previous recipients who are reapplying must maintain a 3.0 GPA or better.
- Must demonstrate financial need.
- > Preference will be given to U.S. citizens.
- Must be available to have lunch with donor before end of current academic year

Luster E. Hauth Scholarship (\$3,000)

- Must be a full-time upper level undergraduate or graduate student.
- > Must be a Communication Studies major or minor.
- Must commit to working an average of 6 hours per week in the Luster E. and Audrey Nichol Hauth Center for Communication Skills during the semester of the award.
- > Must have at least a minimum cumulative 3.5 GPA.
- Must demonstrate financial need.

- > Must be a declared major or minor within the Jewish Studies program.
- Must maintain a GPA of 3.5 or better.
- > Students with financial need will be given preference.
- Applicants are encouraged to submit a personal statement explaining why they should receive this award
