Abstract: Suicide is a major public health concern, and the second leading cause of death among adolescents in the US. Despite decades of research, progress in reducing suicide has been slow. We review the prevalence, correlates, and treatment of suicidality in adolescents. We present findings from several clinical studies aimed to better understand and reduce suicidal behaviors and nonsuicidal self-injury, and describe current projects underway at the UCLA Youth Stress and Mood Program.
