Aus der Zeit lovingly offers a portrait of a dying breed: the independent family store owners in Vienna. In Europe, where economic prudence is becoming the rule, where the big either eclipses or absorbs the small, more and more traditional Mom & Pop shops are vanishing at an alarming rate. *Aus der Zeit* is a documentary which focuses on four of these small local shops: a butcher shop, a drug store, a leatherwear shop and a specialty button shop.

By the end of the film only one of these shops will have survived. Silently observed by the camera, the film unfolds as a portrayal of relationships, a chronicle of memories, a portrait of working conditions, and a testament of love, loneliness, and the passing of time.

The film is presented in German with English subtitles. All are welcome.
