The working title of his current research project is "Best selling stories in Eighteenth- and Nineteenth-Century Italy: a comparative study". Dr. Palmieri will teach in the multiple departments this year. He will also collaborate with Professors Donato and Vettore on the new Italian MA program, which begins this Fall.
