What is Gather.Town

Gather.Town is a customizable virtual space that allows for seamless virtual interaction.



HOW TO GET STARTED

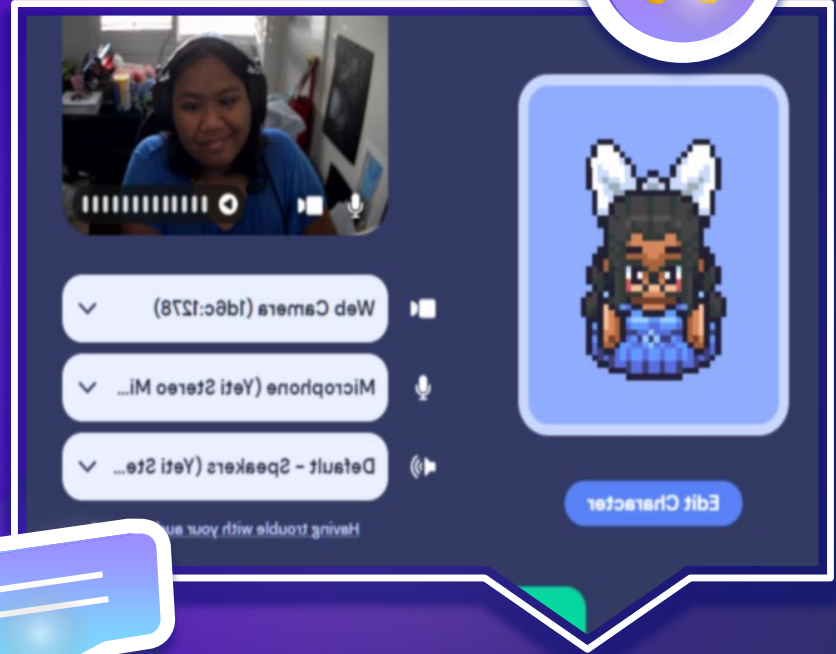
Once you get on [Gather.Town.com](https://gather.town.com) Click Sign In to create an account. After entering an email you'll be prompted to make a character

- Create a character that represents you!
- Please use your real name when you name your character.



Allowing Access

Gather.Town will then ask you to allow access to your camera and your microphone so that you can chat and see other participants. Then click Join Gather.



Navigating Towns

When you first arrive to Town you'll land at the spawn point. To move around towns you can use WASD or your arrow keys.

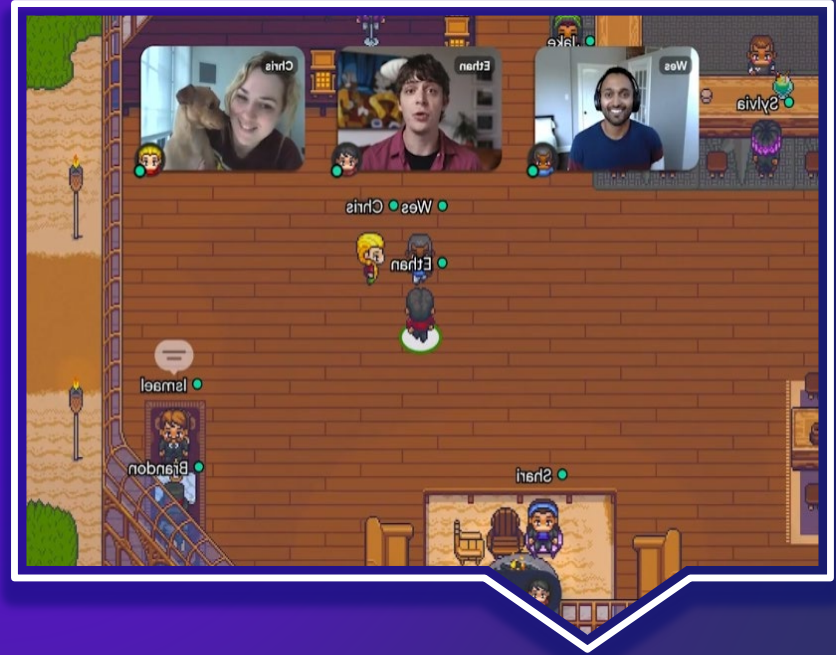
- On the bottom of the page you can see multiple of icons.

Voice and Video Chat

Booths

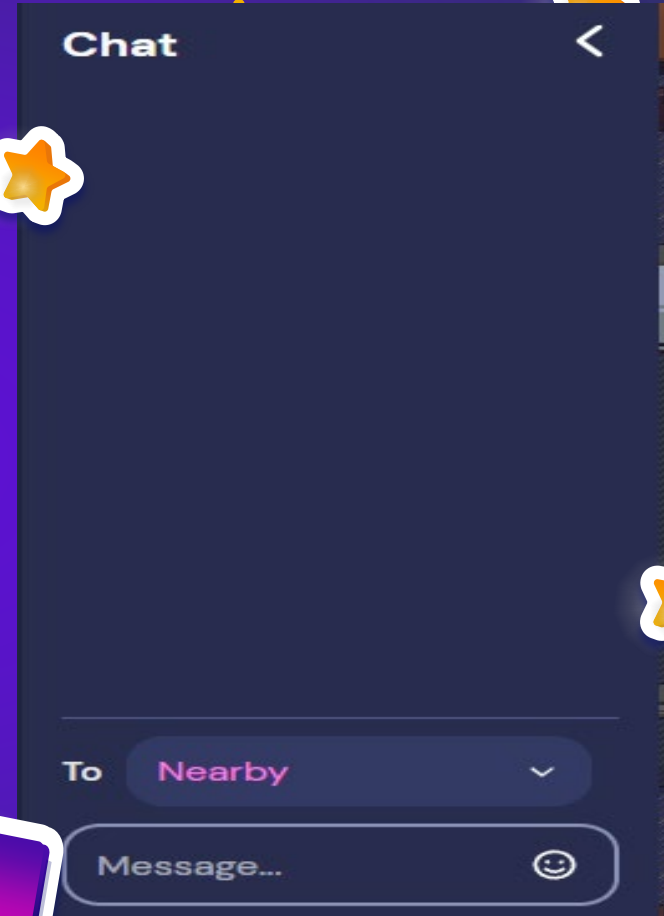


- If you are participating or presenting at World Anthropology Day, you'll be assigned an area where you will be stationed.

Chat Function

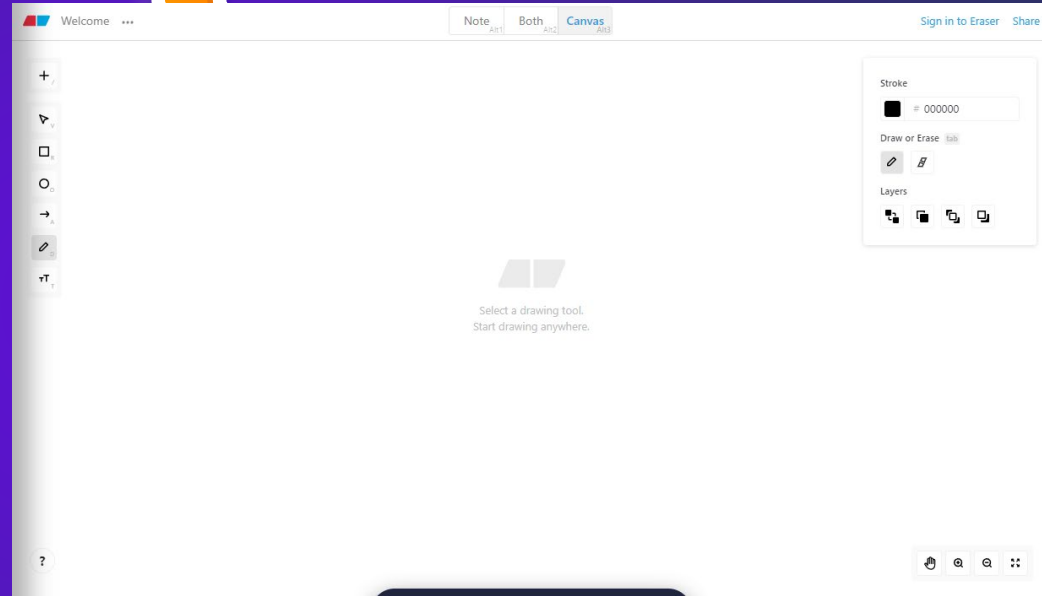
Use the chat function to talk to people either nearby or to everyone!
