## **FAQ CONTEST RULES**

The toy box decorating contest is optional and the rules are minimal. The contest is for all toy drive volunteers to have some creative fun and to increase the visibility of the Toy Drive.

### **Is there an application?**

No, contestants need only identify themselves to Alessandro, Kristin & Christina.

### **When will the judging begin?**

**December 5 through December 7, 2022**

### **When will the winning boxes be announced?**

December 9, 2022. This coincides with the Staff Council Friday meeting.

### **Will there be 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place finishers?**

Yes.

### **Is there a “grand prize” for 1<sup>st</sup> place?**

Yes, a Fabulous Gift. 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place boxes will receive the glory of recognition

### **Are there any additional requirements?**

Yes. Contestants need to save-the-date: **December 9, 2022 from 8:30 to 10:00 am.** as the 1<sup>st</sup> place finisher will be presented with his/her grand prize at the monthly Staff Council meeting. 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place finishers will also be honored.

### **How will the toy boxes be judged?**

Judges will use scorecards. The criteria will include:

- Visibility (prime location)
- Effort (time and energy)
- Appearance (promotes the toy drive)
- Creativity (stop and stare factor)
- Overall Impression

### **When does the Toy Drive end?**

**Friday, December 16, 2022.**

### **What are the contest rules?**

1. Box must be placed by November 13 at the latest [earlier is better].
2. Box must provide an opening for toys
3. Box must be free-standing [self-supporting].
4. Box must be visible from at least two sides.
5. Box can be any size [average size is 2x2x2 foot box]
6. Box must be accessible to all guests [potential toy contributors].
7. Box must include the official 25<sup>th</sup> Annual Bob Rodgers Toy Drive flyer and box location sign.
8. Box must have a title associated with its design or theme.
9. Box must NOT be a fire hazard if lights/electronics are used.
10. Box must NOT be placed where a person could trip and fall.

Who are the judges? TBD. Judges will recuse themselves from scoring when there is a conflict of interest such as if their department has entered the contest.
